Little Mountains – Foothills of Denver Tour – August 5, 9am-3pm



We head out from Denver to the western foothills and enjoy a visit to Red Rocks Amphitheatre. Red Rocks Amphitheatre is a naturally formed, world-renowned outdoor venue located just fifteen miles west of Denver. Red Rocks Amphitheatre is famous for its star-studded concert roster, natural acoustics, and incomparable ambience as well as its awe-inspiring hiking and biking trails.

Next, we'll enjoy a scenic drive to Lookout Mountain. Our tour guide will share stories of the outrageous lives of the gun-slinging Buffalo Bill Cody and Annie Oakley and visit Buffalo Bill's gravesite overlooking Golden and the Front Range.

Finally, we'll visit Golden, Colorado, where we will enjoy a lovely sit-down lunch. Golden was the "almost Capital" of Colorado. The city of Golden was established at the foot of Lookout Mountain in 1859, as prospectors searched for gold in the Colorado hills. This quaint town is the home of the Colorado School of Mines, Miller-Coors Brewery, and historic buildings dating back to 1859, having endured a colorful past ranging from shoot-outs to Prohibition. Golden is also home to the Buffalo Rose Saloon, a well-respected Country Music venue.
