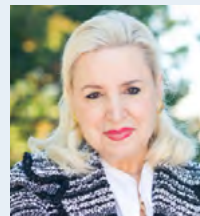

Ambassador Dr. Barfuor Adjei-Barwuah

His Excellency, Dr. Barfour Adjei-Barwuah is the current Ambassador of the Republic of Ghana to the United States, having begun his term in July 2017. This is his second Diplomatic Assignment having previously served as Ambassador of Ghana to Japan, with concurrent accreditation as High Commissioner to Australia, Papua New Guinea, New Zealand, and Singapore from 2001-2008.

As an academic he has served in posts in the US, UK, and Ghana.

Dr. Adjei-Barwuah led the revitalization of Ghana's tourism industry for eight years (1975-1983) having first serve as the last Managing Director of the Ghana Tourism Board and later as first Executive Director of Ghana Tourism Board.
